

Nathan Waters, Keziah and Mallie Pipes

Nathan Waters Pipes, born in 1826 in Mercer County was the oldest son of Nathaniel and Margaret Pipes. Born and raised just east of the Union Cemetery, he was a land owner, farmer, Justice of the Peace and a respected member of the community. He married Keziah (Kizzie) Brand, born 1837 to James Brand and Catherine Link . They were married in 1857 and had two daughters, Fannie Lou and Mallie E. . Mallie 1861 – 1874, died at the young age of 13 and is resting in the same plot as Nathan who died in 1911 and Kizzie who passed in 1912. I cannot find my picture of Mallie but will add it when I do find it. They have the same tall monument with names on the bottom edges.
